## **Professional WorkStation Portfolio**

I have found both the [iPad2](#) and [Samsung Tab 10.1](#) fun machines to use as long as their touch screens didn't have to be used for too much typing. The iLuv Professional WorkStation Portfolio is a beautifully designed leatherette case with a micro suede interior. It is the perfect packaging for its removable keyboard and your tablet. The scissor-type keys really move just like the keys on your Notebook computer. The rechargeable battery that powers this keyboard could give you a month of standby or a week of typing long reports before it needs to be recharged.



Communication between the keyboard and your Tablet is Bluetooth, and the communication is so perfect that if you didn't know that wireless communication was taking place you would assume that the two units were attached. It is extremely easy to slide your Tablet in or out of the case which is definitely a plus if at times you want to use it without the keyboard. iLuv also designed their WorkStation Portfolio for easy detachment and reattachment of the keyboard. It is held in place by Velcro.

To give their case a very professional look they created a swing away metal clasp. When your tablet is not in use this clasp closes the clamshell and holds it closed with a Velcro lock. When you open the case the clasp swings away so it sits out of your way behind the Tablet. The case also includes a pop out kickstand and case cutouts. These openings are perfectly aligned with the locations on your tablet that require access.
